
This book is from the NDIS Review.

The NDIS Quality and Safeguarding Framework says what governments will do to make sure participants



are safe




get good services.



Participants are people who get support from the NDIS.



The NDIS Quality and Safeguarding Framework was made in 2016.



We will call it the Framework.

What people have told us



People have said the Framework does **not** work well for the new ways they use the NDIS.



More participants manage their own plans.



More participants use **providers** who are **not registered**.



Providers give services to participants.



Registered means the provider has to follow some extra steps to show what they do.




There are new types of services that are **not** in the Framework.

For example, services to help participants find workers.



People think the Framework

• is hard to use



 does not say how everyone should work together to keep participants safe.



People want the Framework to work better with other services that keep people safe.

For example

mental health services



 other disability services that are not part of the NDIS.



People want the Framework to do more to **stop** things before they go wrong.

What we know



It can be hard for participants to know

• if a service is good



• if a service is safe



• which services are best for them.



Participants need information to help them choose services.



The Framework needs to balance

• ways to keep everyone safe



• choice and control for participants.



There are many different ideas about what the rules for NDIS providers and workers should be.
