
1. Strengthen the work of the NDIS Quality and Safeguarding Commission

3. Enforce the separation of Supported Independent Living (SIL) and Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA)
4. Implement different prices for registered and unregistered providers

These key reforms are outlined in detail within our submission to the NDIS Review Panel which we have included as a PDF in our uploaded files.

We are eager to discuss these reforms and their potential impact further. Therefore, I would like to request a meeting with the NDIS Independent Review Panel to present our recommendations and explore opportunities for collaboration in creating a more inclusive and supportive future for all people with disability.
